About ECLIPSE. Citizenship Education



ECLIPSE is a 2.5years Comenius multilateral project which started in October 2011.

The Consortium involves six partners

coming from 6 countries (Germany, Italy, Poland, Portugal, Spain and United Kingdom), with complementary expertise in education of young people and in training teachers. Moreover, the network allows exchange of knowledge and best practices, good premise for a quality work in the closed interdependent member countries of the European Union, and produce theoretic and practical results.

Main aim of the project

The aim of the project is to work together in order to contribute to the improvement and to develop, test, and implement an European Citizenship Education Programme for pupils age 13-14 in lower secondary education.

Additionally the Consortium will develop a teacher conference promoting necessary skills and background knowledge for implementing citizenship education in lower seconday education.

1st Project Meeting in Tenerife, Canarian Islands

The Consortium met in January for the first time in order to discuss the plan of the project and the first steps to find schools and associated partners and to disseminate the project. They worked collaboratively on tailor-made materials for teachers according to their needs.

Plans for the 2nd Project Meeting in Lisboa, Portugal

During the next meeting we will discuss:

- ► results of our comparison of the school systems and of the curricula for citizenship education
- ► deepen the research
- ▶ exchange best practices to present and deep teacher training methodologies as classroom and school based action research, teachers' critical reflection, selfassessment, metacognition and learning to learn
- ▶ start to develop a curriculum for the inservice training of teachers
- ▶ choose topics related to European citizenship to be implemetented in schools emphasize elements which are ransversal among the partners, but also elements that are specific in relation to the different cultural approaches.
